live organ option with projection/streaming of *Ada/Ava* or *Frankenstein*

Venues with access to organs can present *Ada/Ava* and *Frankenstein* shows with the option of live organ accompaniment. (At the time of this writing, *Ada/Ava*'s score has been transcribed for organ and *Frankenstein*'s could be available within two months). Presenters can hire organist from within the region who will be able to travel safely to their venue to rehearse and perform during pandemic restrictions.

The full-length recordings of *Ada/Ava* and *Frankenstein* can be projected inside your theater (with socially distanced audiences); projected outside (with outdoor audiences socially distanced on lawns or in a park, or in a "drive-in" format); and/or streamed online, with the score performed live.

With their themes and content, both *Ada/Ava* and *Frankenstein* are conducive to organ accompaniment. You can see trailers here:

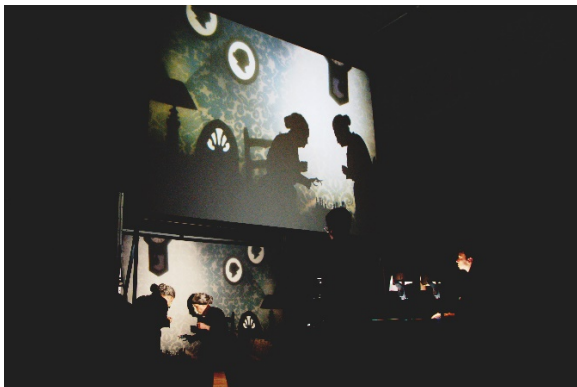
